



Grace and peace to you from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ!

The Lutheran Church is a teaching and confessing church that centers itself around the Word of the gospel of Jesus Christ and the Sacraments. Each month we are going through The Augsburg Confession which is the summary of our beliefs and what we have in common with the whole Christian church. This month we will look at the Sixth Article: Faith will produce good works.

"It is also taught that such faith should yield good works and that a person must do such good works as God has commanded for God's sake but not place trust in them as if thereby to earn grace before God. For we receive forgiveness through faith in Christ, as Christ himself says(Luke 17:10) When you have done all things...say we are worthless slaves." The Fathers also teach the same thing, For Ambrose says: "It is determined by God that whoever believes in Christ shall be saved and have forgiveness of sins, not through works but through faith alone, without merit(as a gift)."

Timothy Wengert on his commentary on the Sixth article describes teaching a class on the Lutheran witness to the gospel on grace that a member says, "So we're saved by grace alone, right? "Yes" Wengert replied with some pride. "Well", he added, "Just don't tell the kids!" His comment demonstrates that Paul's objection in Romans 6 can only arise when all works are excluded in our relationship to God."

Wengert continues that the way we describe things in theology makes a difference. This is why the "before and after" or "If..then" can be problematic if you make it about how we must do something to make God love or save us then our view of salvation is no longer is God's work but becomes our work alone and we carry the burden of trying to please and appease God. We are set free to do good works when we realize that our salvation is in God's hands and God's love is always there for us. The ELCA motto of God's work, our hands" is not meant to say our hands bring about God's work but because of God's work we are free and able to use our hands, feet, voice for our neighbors and it is all a gift. So the preachers job is to place "the word of the promise of God's mercy and grace in people's ears not a agenda of things that must be done or else." In other words, preach the word and give them the sacraments (give them Jesus) and they will bear fruit.
