

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ!

We have been looking at Lutheran Cards by Pastor Dave Daubert that talks about the basics of the Lutheran faith using a stack of cards to explain it. I am going to go through these points each month in our newsletter. The first Card was the Ace-There is no way to God (Period) God comes to us. The Second Card was the "The King. The God revealed in Christ is different. "The King" is Jesus who reveals God is love. The crucified and Risen Jesus stands as the central figure in our faith. The Third card is the Queen-Grace for us includes hope for others. As Lutheran Christians we emphasize grace. Grace is unconditional and comes freely as a gift by faith alone. If God is gracious to us, we should be gracious to others.

This month we are looking at the Jack-Vocation of the Baptized. As baptized children of God we all have a calling and vocation from God. Holy Calling is not just for pastors, Sunday School, Bible teachers, and people who work at the church. Luther's insight was that God can and does use you anywhere.

Dave Daubert says, "The new insight for the church was that God can use people in all occupations and roles to serve as instruments. There is nothing more holy than a parent, a farmer, a teacher, or any of the many roles that people live out in the world. These are all ways that God uses people to contribute to making it work well. God is at work in each and every situation in the lives of people."

It is all God's work! God's work, our hands! We remember our baptism where we see both as a gift that brings life and a call to join in with God's work. The vocation of the baptized frees us all from the burden of finding that one special thing we can do that is pleasing to God. We are set free to live our lives and do God's work in all that we do. God has called you where you are to be the best that you can be to glorify God. Next month we will look at the Ten Card-Priesthood of all Believers which will expand on this more.





