Grace and peace to you from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ!

The Lutheran Church is a teaching and confessing church that centers itself around the Word of the gospel of Jesus Christ and the Sacraments. Each month we are going through The Augsburg Confession which is the summary of our beliefs and what we have in common with the whole Christian church. This month we will look at the Fifth Article: Faith comes through means through the Holy Spirit. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God and Sacraments:

"So that we may obtain this faith, the ministry of teaching the gospel and administering the sacraments was instituted. For through the Word and the sacraments as through instruments the Holy Spirit is given, who effects faith where and when it pleases God in those who hear the gospel, that is to say, in those who hear that God not on account of our merits but on account od Christ, justifies those who believe that they have received into grace on account of Christ. (Galatians 3:14b)"

Timothy Wengert on his commentary on the fifth article recalls how popular Christianity talks a lot about "amazing grace" and the love of Jesus but when it comes to faith there is always an insistence of "a decision we make, a commitment we undertake in order to get into a right, saving relationship with God." There is always something that is all up to us and "because God loves us, we must etc, etc. When that happens then all is lost, and we are thrust back upon ourselves and our work. Faith does not depend on our working but rather on God's action. God acts by sending the Word and Holy Spirit to make believers out of them. God uses the preaching office of giving the Word and Sacraments to people. The Holy Spirit uses the means of grace to make us believers. We receive the promises of God by faith.

As Martin Luther explains in the Third article of the Creed in the Small Catechism:

"I believe that by my own understanding or strength that I cannot believe in Jesus Christ or come to him, but instead the Holy Spirit has called me through the gospel, enlightened me with his gifts, made me holy and kept me in the true faith."

The Word from God did everything. The gospel is a gift, and the sacraments of Baptism and Holy Communion are too. These gifts are for you!


