



Dietrich Bonhoeffer, a witness of Jesus Christ among his brethren. Born February4th, 1906 in Breslau. Died April 9, 1945, in Flossenberg. He was killed by the Nazis. Bonhoeffer was a great Lutheran theologian and in the next couple of newsletters I will be giving you insights from his book "Life Together" The Classic Exploration of Christian Community.

Chapter 1 is about Community. Psalm 133: 1 proclaims "How Very good and pleasant it is when kindred live together in Unity (NRSVUE). We take it for granted that we can come together as Christians to worship. Jesus Christ lived in the midst of his enemies. In the end, his disciples deserted him. Remember even Peter denied him three times. He was forsaken and alone on the cross surrounded by his enemies and those who mocked him. He brought peace to his enemies on the cross. He died for all sinners including all of us. God's people come together in the midst of those who are against the truth of the gospel. God has called us not to be lone rangers but to come together in one body with other Christians to gather around Word and Sacrament. It is by the grace of God that a congregation is permitted to gather visibly in the world to share God's word and Sacraments. Not all Christians receive this blessing. The imprisoned, the sick, the scattered lonely, the proclaimers of the gospel in lands that forbid the preaching and gathering of Christians are alone. They know that visible fellowship is a blessing. Sadly, here in the United States and other Western countries it is not seen as a blessing. Many do not think fellowship with other Christians are not essential. Church attendance is in decline and churches are closing. Bonhoeffer said, "Christianity means community through Jesus Christ. No Christian community is more or less than this. We belong to one another only through and in Jesus Christ." We need one another because of Jesus Christ. The Christian no longer lives only to their own self, claims, or justification. The Christians lives totally by God's claim and justification alone. The Christian lives by God's word declared upon them. The Christian lives wholly by the truth of God's Word in Christ. The one Christ loved, became human, died and rose again for forgiveness of sins and new life. Remember we are bound together by faith not by experience. Our unity is in Jesus and it is not in sameness. There is no room for sectarianism and exclusivism in God's church. We are the body of Christ for the world. Making Jesus Known because of God's grace alone.





